Moved by Willardson, second by Promes to approve the agreement between owner and engineer for professional services with JEO Consulting Group, Inc. for the pool slide project. Motion carried-unanimous.

Moved by Promes, second by Willardson to approve spending up to \$500.00 of local option funds to purchase extra materials for golf course shed door project. Motion carried-unanimous.

Willardson moved to approve the paying of November bills, second by Promes. Motion carried-unanimous.

Adjourning of the meeting at 7:15 p.m. moved by Willardson, second by Streit. Motion carried-unanimous.
