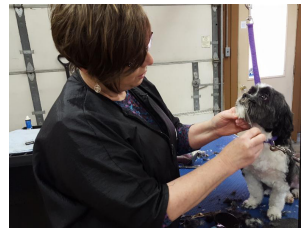
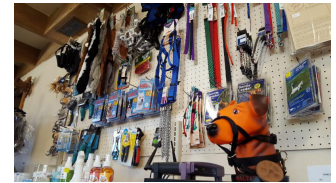
Sibyl provides grooming for small dogs. She also started designing and making her own grooming bows and offering them online - visit
